

Warren County Public Library Camp – FAQs

What are WCPL Camps?

Every year Warren County Public Library hosts camps to engage school-aged children during the summer months (June/July). Our goal is to keep children active, both mentally and physically, and to prevent 'educational slide' that can occur during the summer months. Camps are generally for children ages 7-16 years old, but do vary dependent on the content. *When you are registering, please make sure to double-check your chosen camp's date, time, location and suggested age range to ensure it's a good fit for your child!*

What is STEM?

STEM is an acronym for the fields of science, technology, engineering and math. Discussion of STEM-related programs has become a priority because too few individuals, particularly various underserved groups, are pursuing degrees in these fields.

How long does a camp last?

WCPL STEM camps lasts five days, Monday-Friday, from 9 am-12 pm unless otherwise noted. Some exceptions to this are STEM Camps at Smiths Grove and Graham Drive Community Library and special camps such as Theatre Camp. Other specialty camps can last anywhere from a week to just two days. *Make sure to double-check the date, time and location of the camp you are registering for to make sure it is the best fit for you and your child.*

Where do I register?

Every year WCPL activates its camp page at warrenpl.org/camps. Here you can see what kind of camps are being offered and you will be able to register by clicking the date of your chosen camp. All registrations are first come, first served (except for Theatre Camp). If the camp that you would like to register for is full, please register on the corresponding wait list. You will be contacted in the order that you were placed on the list if space becomes available.

Should I sign up for multiple camps?

All regular STEM Camps will have the same content, **so please only sign up for one**. However, WCPL also offers a variety of other camps which vary year-to-year. Feel free to sign up for one, or more, of these in addition to a regular STEM Camp.

Will I receive confirmation after I register?

By successfully submitting a camp registration form via our webpage at warrenpl.org/camps, you are confirmed to attend camp during that week! After initial registrations have taken place, you will receive an email welcoming you to your WCPL camp and giving you further instruction. This can take up to 1-2 weeks after registration.

I'm having trouble registering online, what should I do?

Please call one of our locations and speak to a staff member about registering. We can walk you through the process over the phone, or we can enter your information into our registration form with your permission.
