THRIVE Lead

Up to 20 hrs/week \$13/hr

Responsibilities: Provide children's programming to areas of need in Warren County and event support for Summer Reading programming. Lead and support a team of THRIVE staff (student workers) to provide fun and interactive programs and activities at library and parks facilitated summer camps, pop-up events, local neighborhoods, and library events.

Requirements: 22 years of age or older to be on our insurance (you will be operating a library vehicle to drive to various locations), ability to work indoors and outdoors and physically move materials and yourself to a variety of locations.

The 2025 THRIVE season begins on Monday June 2 and runs through Friday Aug 1.

Duties include but are not limited to:

- Provide on-site leadership at Family Day Camps (elementary school children and their adults) in partnership with Warren County Parks and Recreation (welcome families, help facilitate games & crafts, set-up and help clean-up the camp supplies at the end of the day).
- Visit area neighborhoods, community centers, and partner organizations to provide games, storytimes, and programs/crafts to children ages 2-16 along with a team of THRIVE staff.
- Support large WCPL events such as Summer Reading Kickoff, Movies at the Capitol, and other youth and family programs. Assist with greeting guests, crowd management, clean up, and support with crafts/program activities.
- Manage a group of student assistants (THRIVE staff) that will be working in support and conjunction with you at these programs and events.
