# FAQ: Little Free Shuttle

## Where in Warren County is the Little Free Shuttle?

## Who can ride the Little Free Shuttle?

Anyone is eligible to ride the Little Free Shuttle - no library card or ID needed! WCPL offers this transit service freely to everyone in the community in the hopes that it will meet patrons where they are and increase access to library locations.

## Why does the Warren County Public Library offer a transit service?

The mission statement of WCPL is: *to improve patron quality of life by providing access and information services which enables patrons, regardless of economic standing, to take one step forward in their pursuit of an enjoyable equitable life.* Expanding mobility by providing access to transport for our patrons fits well into our mission! WCPL also offers Home Delivery and Door-to-Door services that connect patrons with library materials. The Little Free Shuttle is complementary to those outreach services: in addition to going out to patrons, we also bring them to us! As a result, more in-house services become accessible! ## What's it like to ride the Little Free Shuttle?

It's a safe, free, climate-controlled, 15-passenger van. While the Little Free Shuttle isn't equipped with a ramp, it has an optional two-step stool with handle, max capacity 450 lbs. Ask the driver if you need assistance with boarding!

## How can riders pass the time between destinations on the Little Free Shuttle?

Riders can immerse themselves in a good book, utilize WCPL's digital resources (like Libby and Hoopla), snag a few items from the Community Care Collection — including rain ponchos, \*emergency water, body wipes, menstrual products, \*\*handwarmers, and \*\*mylar blankets — or simply enjoy the view out the window!
